

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Weston Board was held on Tuesday, April 11, 2023 at the Town of Weston Hall. Present Bruce Podoll, Craig Lecheler, Curt Heit, Cindy Wang, and Pat Pickerign.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bruce Podoll at 7:00 p.m.

The minutes of the March meeting were read. Curt Heit moved and Craig Lecheler seconded to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given. A motion was made by Curt Heit and seconded by Craig Lecheler to accept the treasurer's report as given. Motion carried.

There were no public comments.

MEETING REPORTS: Bruce Podoll and Curt Heit attended the Board of Review training webinar.

Bruce attended the Dunn County Unit meeting of the WTA. Somethings talked about were: Some grants for roads are available, Struggling to keep EMS and firefighters, Shared revenue – bigger cities get larger amount than other cities, Money available for bridges.

ROADWORK: Jody Anderson reported that he had cutting brush, still plowing, and grading roads.

Bruce Podoll reported the price of rock was up a \$1.00 a ton -- \$7.00 to \$8.05; \$9.00 at county. It is \$7.80 at the Miller pit, but you have to load it yourself.

The new town truck will be built in July with delivery in July, then it will be sent to Universal to have the equipment put on. Will have to pay for truck when it leaves Marshfield to go to Universal.

State Trust Funds have a 5% interest rates. Interest money earned pays for library materials

Bank loans have one payment due after taxes are paid.

ALICIVIA: Clerk is to contact ALICIVIA for the fuel receipts for the last 3 years to apply for federal gas tax refund. April 2020 – 2021, April 2021 -2022, April 2022 – 2023.

ROAD TOUR was tentatively set for 9:00 a.m. on April 20, 2023.

MYER'S DRIVEWAY: Craig Lecheler moved to approve the driveway permit for Lisa Myer's driveway with the following requirements: Rock is okay now, but if they build or improve the site for a home or residential site, a culvert will have to be installed. Curt Heit seconded. Motion carried.

BAR OPERATOR'S LICENSE FOR CAITLIN BURTON: Curt Heit made a motion to approve a bar operator's license for Caitlin Burton. Craig Lecheler seconded. Motion carried.

VOUCHERS: Curt Heit moved and Bruce Podoll seconded to pay the vouchers presented. Motion carried.
