

The regular monthly meeting was held on Wednesday, August 10, 2022 at the Town of Weston Hall. Present were Bruce Podoll, Craig Lecheler, Curt Heit, Pat Pickerign, and Cindy Wang.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bruce Podoll at 7:00 p.m.

The minutes of the July meeting were read. A motion was made by Curt Heit and seconded by Craig Lecheler to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried.

Public Comments: None

MEETING REPORT: Bruce Podoll attended the meeting of the Dunn County Unit of the Wisconsin Town's Association. Drug testing is now being done by a private entity and not by the county. All UTV routes will be on county roads.

ROADWORK: Jody Anderson has been grader patching, cutting trees on the town roads right of ways, and grading roads.

Curt Heit moved and Craig Lecheler seconded to approve the increase in Scott's Construction bid to chip seal using hot oil and 100% fractured granite chips to \$111,007.00 for the following roads: 310th Avenue (Cty Rd K to 350th St.) for \$15,382.00; 250th Ave. (Hwy 72 to 220th St.) for \$66,169.00; 470th Ave. (Old seal to Town line) for \$13,467.00; Downtown St. (.48 mile) for \$15,989.00. Motion carried.

BROADBAND: The broadband project to complete laying fiber optic cable in the Town of Weston may start this fall. The fiber optic will not be completed to Kuehl's and Ginsbach on top of the hill by the quarry.

ARPA fund projects have been placed on hold.

180th Street - No action taken.

Zoning issues: Wayne Webinger has talked Chairman Bruce Podoll about people gathering on the property owned by Jacob Johnson. They set up campsites with no water or toilets available.

DRIVEWAY PERMITS: Curt Heit moved to approve driveway permits for Rick Trainor and Tom Newbauer. Craig Lecheler seconded. Motion carried.

VOUCHERS: Craig Lecheler moved and Curt Heit seconded to pay the vouchers presented. Motion carried.

PRE-PAY PROPANE: Craig Lecheler moved and Curt Heit seconded to prepay 2750 gallons of propane at the price of \$2.02 a gallon for a total of \$5,555.00. Motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT: Craig Lecheler moved and Curt Heit seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
