

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Weston Board was held on Tuesday, February 13, 2024 at the Town of Weston Hall. Present were Bruce Podoll, Curt Heit and Pat Pickerign. Supervisor Gavin Styer and Treasurer Cindy Wang were absent.

The meeting was call to order by Chairman Bruce Podoll at 7:00 p.m.

The minutes of the January meeting were read. Curt Heit moved and Bruce Podoll seconded to approve the minutes as read. Motion caried.

In the absence of the treasurer, there was no treasurer's report.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Curt Heit videoed the town truck for selling.

MEETING REPORTS: The county will do the culvert inventory. Not sure about inspections.

DISCUSSION & ACTION ITEMS:

Roadwork: Jody Anderson had been cutting brush. Driver's side window on truck doesn't work. Jody had gotten prices for front tires for the tractor. Durand Bauer Built price was \$2,200.00 and Farm Tires of Woodville price was \$1,808.00. Curt Heit moved to purchase the tires from Farm Tires of Woodville for the front tires at a cost of \$1,808.00. Bruce Podoll seconded. Motion carried.

Menomonie Fire Department Committee: Discussion was held on what to cover and how to move forward. Menomonie doesn't bill for residents. Towns don't pay for inspections. A charge on service time is being considered.

New Truck Update. The new truck may be in shop in April, if not March.

West Wisconsin Telecom: It is felt that the broadband company needs to do some clean up especially on Comfort Road. Jody is to write down spots that need to be looked at. Bruce Podoll will call Todd Sisko to make sure landscaping is done up to satisfaction.

Bruce will check on the Ag Road Grant.

Vouchers: Curt Heit moved and Bruce Podoll seconded to pay vouchers presented. Motion carried. Curt Heit moved and Bruce Podoll seconded to have the clerk take \$32,000.00 out of money market (ARPA Funds) to pay Chimney Rock Appraisal for the town's re-evaluation. Motion carried.

Curt Heit moved and Bruce Podoll seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
