

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Weston Board was held on Tuesday, June 14, 2022. Present were Bruce Podoll, Craig Lecheler, Curt Heit, Pat Pickerign, and Cindy Wang.

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by Chairman Bruce Podoll.

The minutes of the May meeting were read. A motion was made by Curt Heit and seconded by Craig Lecheler to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given. Craig Lecheler moved and Curt Heit seconded to approve the treasurer's report. Motion carried.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Bruce Podoll and Craig Lecheler were out clearing roads the night of the storm.

**DISCUSSION & ACTION ITEMS:**

**ROADWORK:** Jody Anderson reported that he was done grading roads, has been patching roads, and cutting trees along town roads.

A discussion was held on what specific road work should be done. Scott's Construction bid to do 190<sup>th</sup> Street was \$182,500.00. County would want to lay warm mix for \$138,750.00. To do, 290<sup>th</sup> Street from County Road K to 290<sup>th</sup> Avenue (to Randy Styers) 1 mile would be \$120,000.00 with an overlay of 2 inches, spray, and shouldering.

A discussion was held on borrowing the money to do all the road projects and putting the payment on the tax levy.

Craig Lecheler moved and Curt Heit seconded to allow the chairman to make a decision to sealcoat roads not to exceed \$100,000.00. Motion carried.

**CHRISTMAS TREE LANE:** Curt Heit moved to send Ken Brown a bill for \$750.00 for damage done on Christmas Tree Lane with his farm equipment when he pulled out from his field. The bill would include 4 hours of labor and use of equipment at \$125.00 per hour and \$250.00 for blacktop. Motion carried.

A letter is to be sent to Alfalawn Farm about road damage done on 290<sup>th</sup> Ave. by one of their employees. Bruce Podoll has talked to Randy Styer about the damage. It was decided that they would wait until next year for billing to see if the summer heat would repair the damage.

**TOWN TRUCK:** The unofficial cost of the new truck is \$134,363.00 because of the price increase by 2024.

**PIT LAKE RECYCLING CONTRACT:** Curt Heit moved and Craig Lecheler seconded to sign the Pit Lake Intergovernmental Agreement with the Town of Dunn. Motion carried.
