DISCUSSION & ACTION ITEMS:

371st STREET UPDATE: The lawyer has the necessary papers for vacating 371st sent to the register of deeds to be recorded. No other action needs to be done.

RIGHT OF WAY PERMITS: A discussion of the pros and cons of requiring permits to bury in the Town road right of way was held. The question as to who should be responsible for the permits. It was the consensus of the board that the town patrolman should be responsible for the permits. This item is to be placed on the February meeting agenda.

DISTRICT MEETING: The clerk was directed to register Bruce Podoll, Craig Lecheler, and Curt Heit to attend the virtual district meeting to be held on March 28, 2022.

A motion was made by Craig Lecheler and seconded by Curt Heit to change the February meeting to Monday, February 7, 2022 because of a primary election on the eighth. Motion carried.
